Native American Heritage Month

November is **National Native American Heritage Month**, and we're celebrating the history of Native Americans within the YMCA.

The first YMCA serving U.S. Native American was founded in 1879 by the son of Chief Little Crow, Thomas Wakeman, a Dakota Native, in Flandreau, South Dakota. After volunteers from the YMCA visited him and others, bringing them clothes and bedding, the Native men started their own Young Men's Association called the Koskada Okadiciye. In 1885, the association was recognized by the national YMCA movement and changed their name to Sioux Young Men's Christian Association. Their goal then, as it still is today, was to teach and encourage the Lakota values of Wawokiye, Woksape, Ohitika, and Wa o'hola (Generosity, Wisdom, Bravery, and Respect) as well as the Y values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility.

Dr. Charles A. Eastman, the first Native American to be certified in Western medicine, began working with the YMCA as the secretary of the International Committee and founded 32 Native American chapters of the YMCA in just four years.

Our very own CEO, Charlene Lyons, is a member of the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina and is currently the only Indigenous YMCA President/CEO in the U.S. She also serves on the Advisory Council to the YMCA of the Seven Council Fires.
